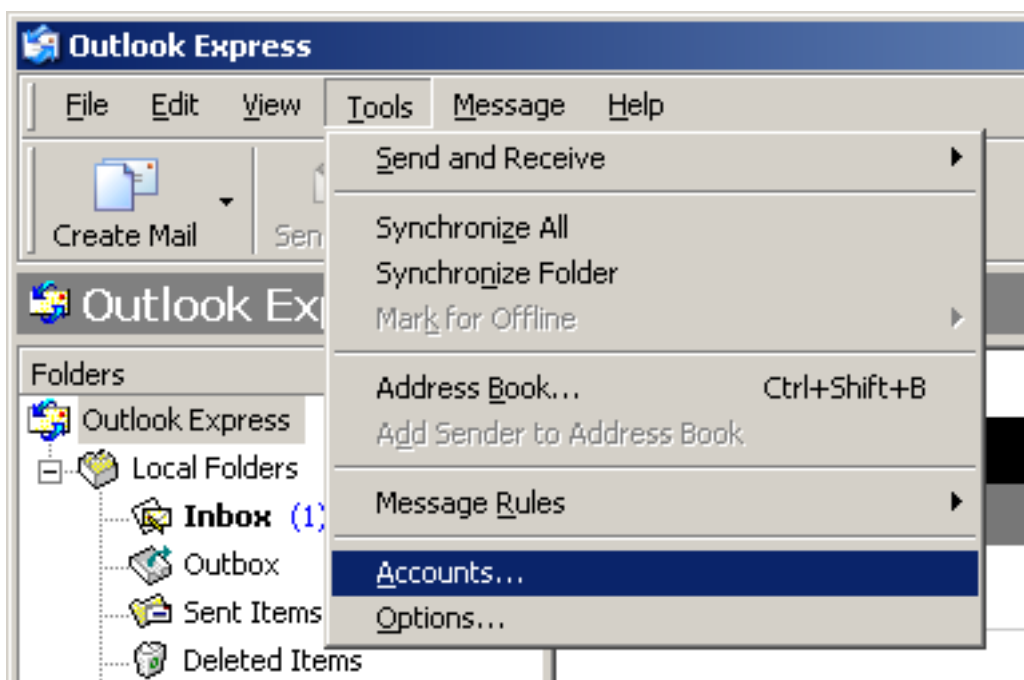


Outlook Express

How can I change my displayed name of sent emails in Microsoft Outlook Express?

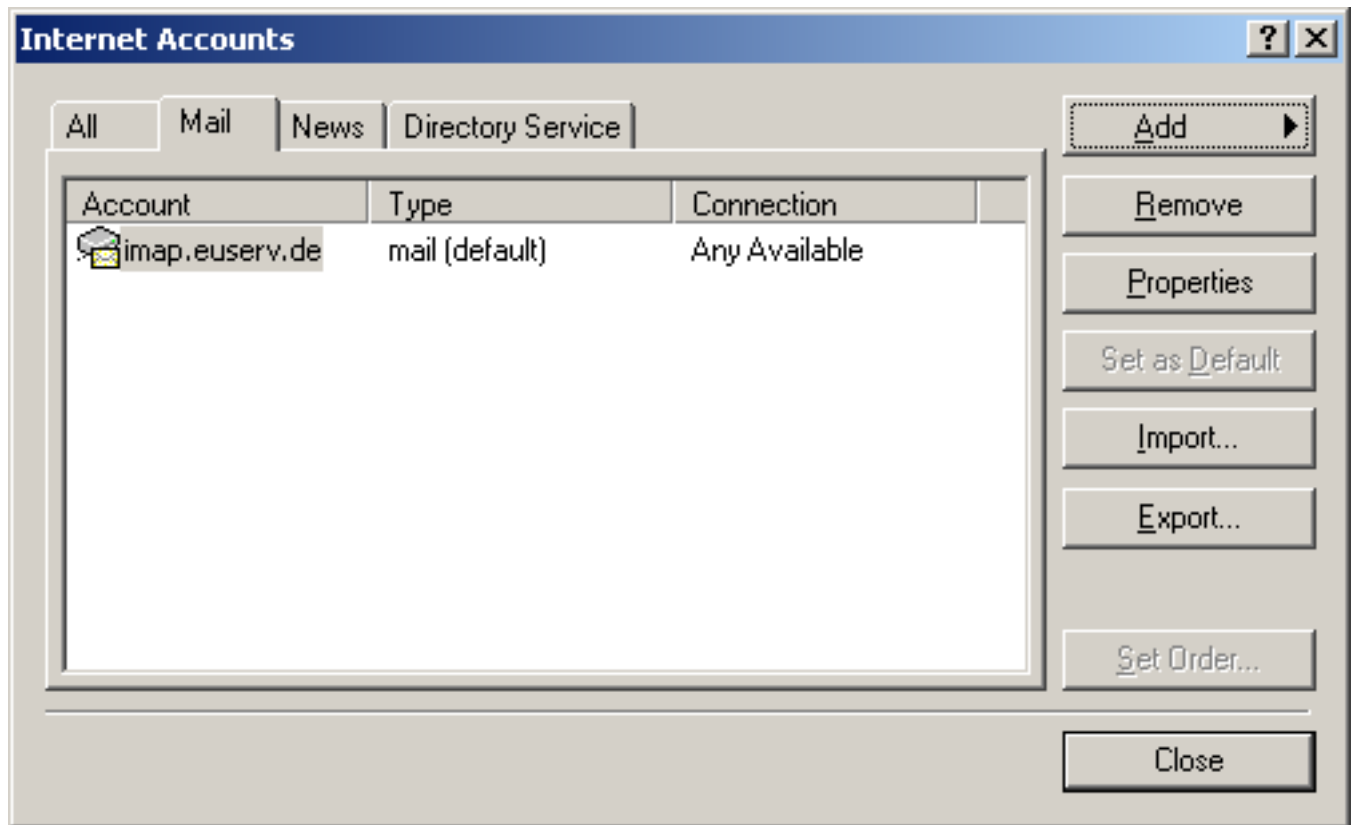
If you use your user name (**popxxxx-xxxxxxxxxxxxxxx**) as default name during the email account setup under Microsoft Outlook, this name popxxxx-xxxxxxxxxxxxxxx [youremail@address.com] will be displayed to the recipient of your email. To change the name of the sender, please proceed as follows:

Click on **Tools** -> **Accounts...**



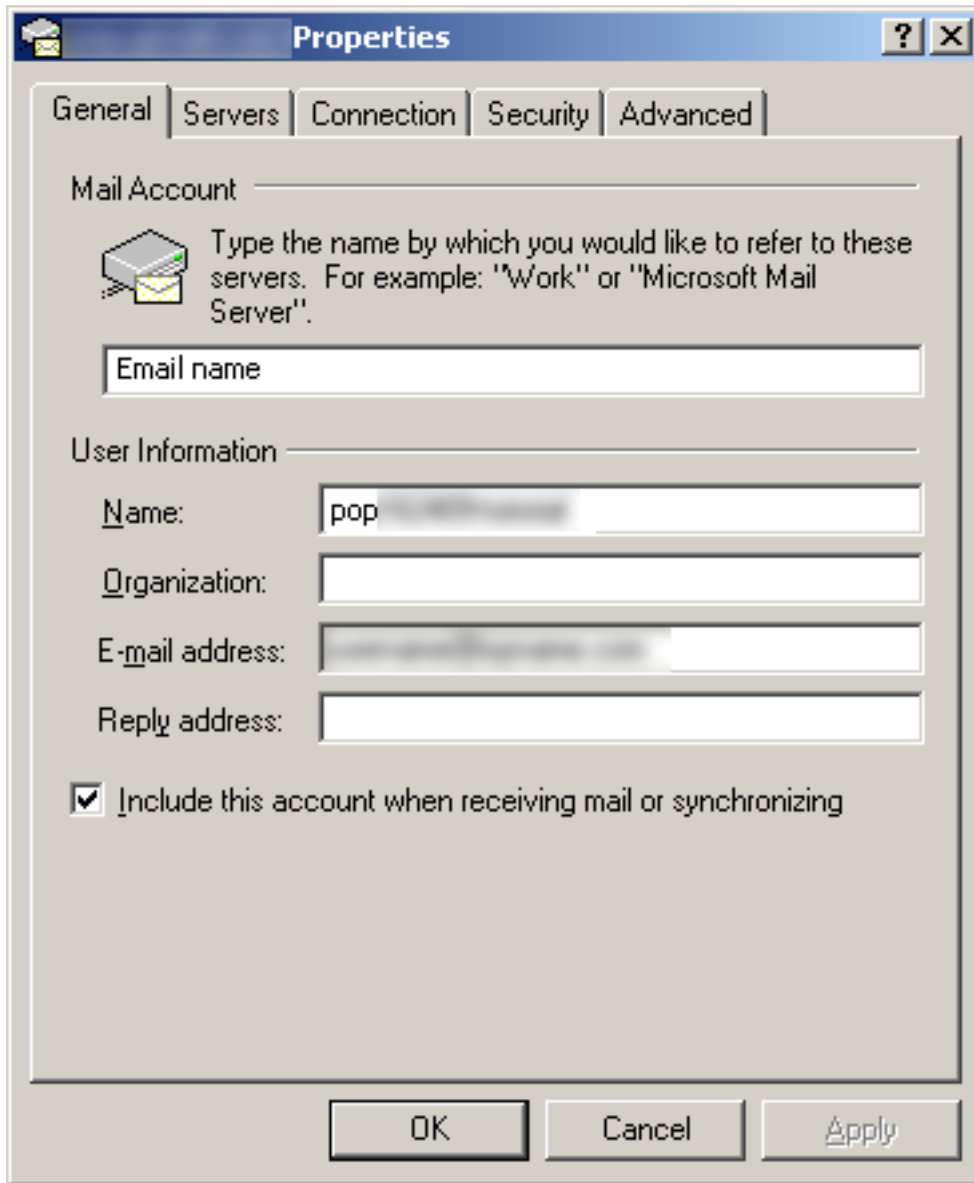
Click on the tab **Mail**, choose your email account and click on **Properties**.

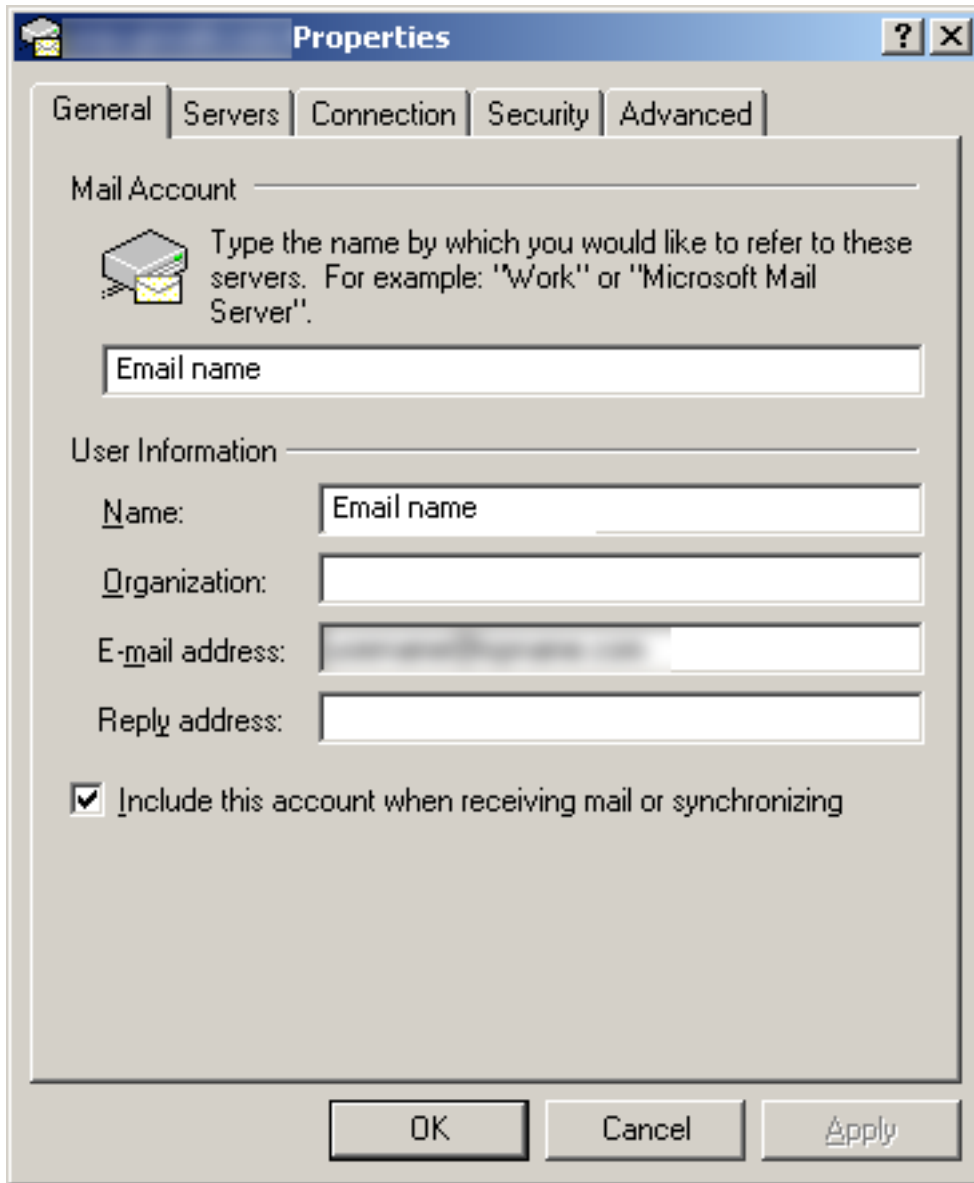
