# How many IP addresses can be used in an IPv6 address block?

The number of maximum usable IPs in an IPv6 address block results of the network prefix.

For example:

**/128** = 1 IPv6 address

**/64** = 1 IPv6 subnet =  $2^{64}$  possible IP addresses
